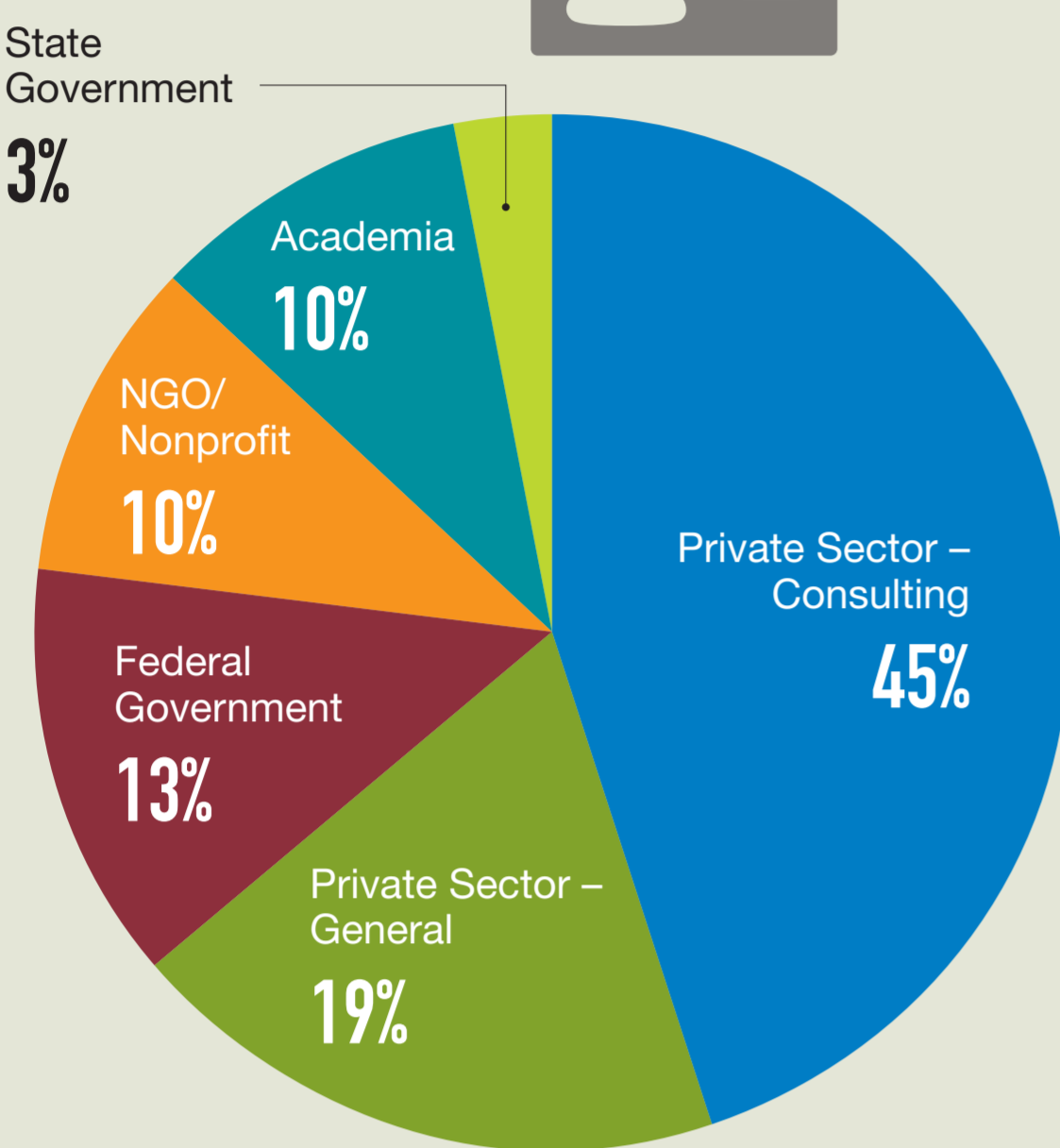

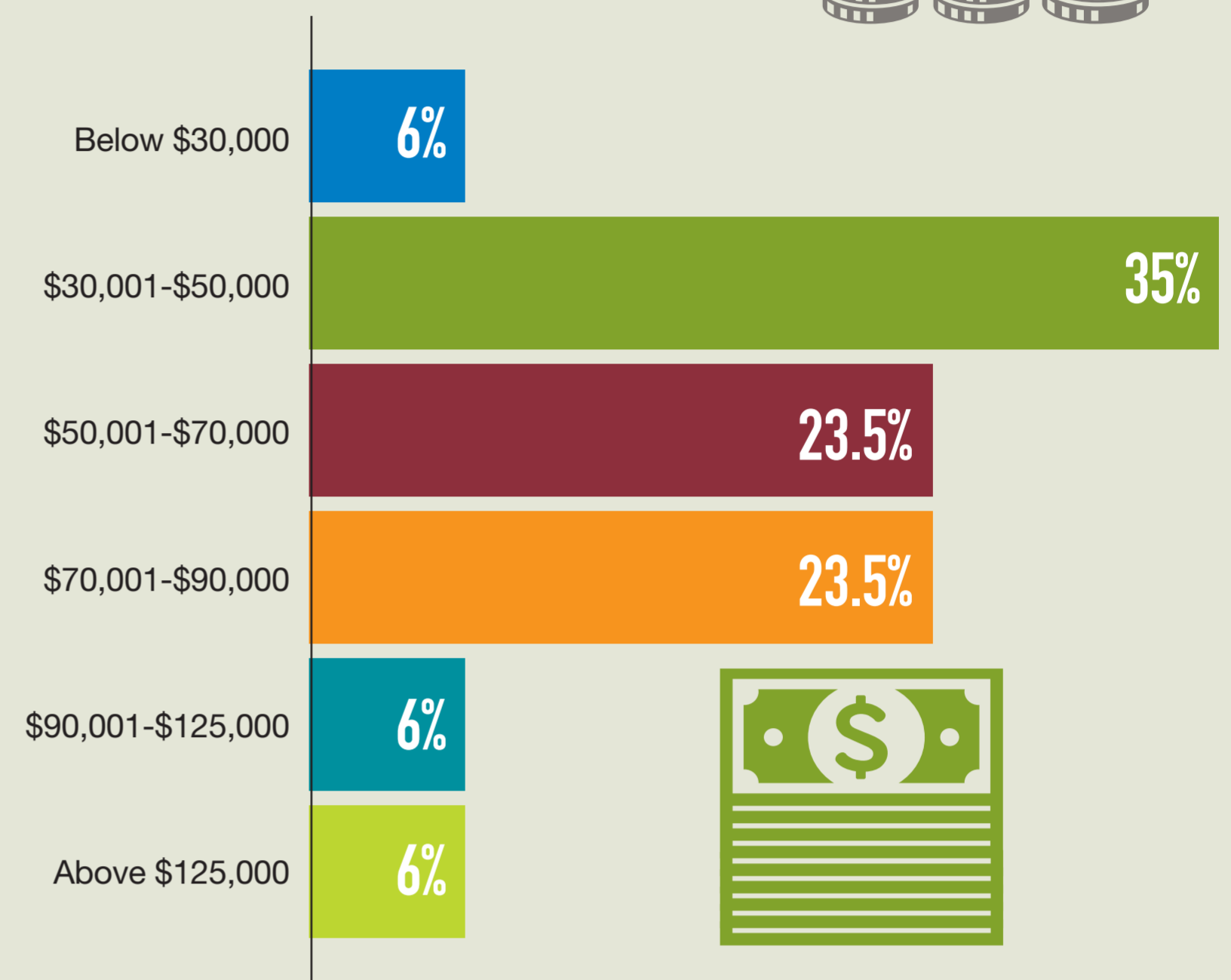
## Biodefense Program Graduates Securing Employment across Industries
